



Program Sponsorship Opportunities:

Tier I

- Film & Video Festival
 - Two free films every Tues., Apr.—June, and Sept., - Nov.
- Virtual Author Talks
 - 2-3 monthly, live virtual talks from bestselling authors and thought leaders.
- Get to Know our Digital Resources Classes
 - Monthly small group workshops centered on one of the Library's Digital Resources (Hoopla, Libby, Mango Languages, etc.)
- Beanstack Reading Challenges
 - Throughout the year, Beanstack (a platform that motivates people to read) offers challenges for readers of all ages. The Library participates in multiple challenges throughout the year, including the Winter Read (January) and Summer Reading (July & August).

Tier II

- African American Film Forum (March)
 - Four free showings of award-winning documentaries about social injustice. In partnership with the NAACP—Glens Falls Branch
- 1,000 Books Before Kindergarten
 - Young readers earn prizes for every hundred books they read to reach the goal of reading 1,000 books before entering kindergarten.
- Teen Dungeons & Dragons
 - Every Saturday a group of Teens meet in the Teen Center to play Dungeons & Dragons to develop social-emotional skills, build confidence, and learn to express themselves.
- Tween Graphic Novel Book Club
 - Monthly book club for youths in grades 5-7 to discuss a graphic novel, partake in a group activity, and receive a free copy of the book
- Summer Story Times in City Park
 - Weekly story times for infant/toddler and preschool-age kids in City Park from June—October (weather permitting).
- Seed Library
 - A seed library is a community-based culture of saving & sharing seeds. The program series runs from April - October.

Tier III

- Teddy Bears Picnic
 - Annual family event in City Park that attracts over 100 local families. Caregivers learn about Library resources, and kids partake in fun activities with their favorite stuffed animals.
- Summer Reading Kick-off Party
 - Annual party in City Park with a large attendance with the goal of signing children and adults up for the Summer Reading Program.
- Summer Children's Program (choice of 1)
 - Throughout the summer the Children's Department hosts multiple special programs for kids of all ages including puppet shows, live animal shows, traveling planetarium, etc.
