HISTORICAL NOTE

The Glens Falls City Band is more than 100 years old. There are newspaper references to the band escorting a crowd to the new roller skating rink on Maple Street in February 1907, performing on the steps of the Rockwell House to see off local troops to World War I, and to its members being part of the American Federation of Musicians, Glens Falls Local 129, established in the late 1890s.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF THE OBJECT

Bass drum, wood, metal and skin construction.; on face is painted "Glens Falls City Band." 28 inches wide x 16 ½ inches tall.
