DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF THE OBJECTS

Wood carving of a man astride a horse. The man has gray hair and a mustache and is wearing a red coat with "brass" (yellow paint) buttons, black pants with a white stripe up the sides, brown riding boots, and a black round brimmed hat. The outfit is reminiscent of a Royal Canadian Mounted Police uniform. The horse is brown with leather reins and a hemp mane and tail. Widest dimensions are approximately 12" x 14".
