## **DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF THE OBJECTS**

The brown trout fish sculpture is made from a wood panel, rough cut, with a wood knot for the fish eye, and is painted. Fins of rusted tin are attached with nails. It is about 4 feet 9 inches long and signed on the back "Tim Reed 2014".
