## SCOPE AND CONTENT OF THE RECORDS

This 12" X 7.5" journal has a tan fabric cover, with "S.E. Ledger" printed on the front. The pages are lined and numbered, with columns for sums. Most of the entries were made in pen, with some in pencil. They are spread throughout the book, but only consume about ¼ of the pages in the ledger. A listing of logging numbers, the daily journal of a logger, and various accounts and figures make up the entries in the book. The names Chas (Charlie) Carver, H. Clark, and Sam Knight are mentioned. Also mentioned are the "Cochrane Job" and the Berkshire Lumber Co. A list of grocery items is made under the heading "Adelbert [bought] of F.G. Creamer". The ledger appears to relate to the personal life and finances of an Upstate NY logger. The owner is unknown.
