HISTORICAL NOTE

The Kingsbury School District No. 2 school was located on Lower Maple Street (now Route 196) in Kingsbury, Washington County, NY. It was also known as the Dunham's Basin School, for the hamlet in which it is located. It was in operation prior to 1843, and continued until 1948. The building is still standing (2011) and is currently a private residence.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF THE RECORDS

Folder 1: Handwritten catalog of the books in the school library, 1846-1847. The list contains 134 books, and was written by O.N. Carleton, who was the teacher in the school in January of 1847. The list is on a single sheet of legal size paper. Also: an annotated transcription identifying the titles listed in the catalog.

Folder 2: Xerographic copies of Trustees Annual Reports 1873-1906 (not inclusive). These copies were obtained by Erica Wolfe Burke from the Washington County Historian's Office in 2009. Reports give financial and statistical information about the school, and in most cases list names of pupils. Reports are included for the following years:
