BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Richard Cavagnola was born in 1964. He received a B.S. from Marist College in Poughkeepsie, NY, in 1986, an M.B.A. from Pace University in New York City in 1994, a B.A. in Photography from Empire State College in 2016, and an M.F.A. in Photography from the New Hampshire Institute of Art in Manchester New Hampshire in 2018.

Cavagnola has exhibited in galleries in Philadelphia, Albany, Somerville MA, several venues in Vermont, and, in 2011 his Open Door Mission Food Pantry series was part of *Foodways: Documenting the Local*, in the Folklife Gallery at Crandall Public Library.

He lives in Mechanicville, NY. His current project "Confessions of Time in Upstate America" explores the social and economic landscape of upstate New York.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF THE OBJECTS

Three CDs

Open Door Mission, Fall 2010, consists of 12 photographs (one disc) of patrons and staff at the Open Door Mission at their second location, on Lawrence Street, in Glens Falls. The Open Door Mission is a soup kitchen and food pantry which was previously located in the Madden Hotel on South Street, until the hotel was demolished.

South Glens Falls Holiday Parade, 2011, consists of 251 photographs (2 discs) of the parade. This traditional event takes place on the Sunday before Thanksgiving Day and proceeds up Saratoga Avenue (Rt. 9) in South Glens Falls, starting at Carriage Traders at the intersection of William Street, and ending at a viewing stand on Main Street. Local businesses, organizations, Scout troops, and others create floats or march in the parade, which concludes with the arrival of Santa Claus.

Prints

Three prints from the series *Confessions of Time in Upstate America*. These archival prints were printed using a Canon Pro-2000 on Hahnemühle Fine Art Baryta. They measure 13 inches x 19 inches.

Glens Falls, NY 2015, printed 2018. This image shows the back of buildings on Fredella Ave. in Glens Falls, with the Finch, Pruyn paper mill in the center distance.

Christmas House, Mechanicville, NY, 2017, printed 2018. Image is front view of a small house covered in red-painted shingles, dusted with snow.
