Shown are paper mills (International Paper, Finch Pruyn), General Electric plant, bridges, dams, canals (especially the Feeder Canal in Glens Falls).

SCOPE AND CONTENT OF THE RECORDS

This collection of Hudson River photographs taken by Gretchen McHugh consists of ten 11 X 14 silver gelatin archival prints and four 42 inch archival panoramic prints (rolled). These photographs all appeared in Gretchen McHugh's exhibit *Harnessing the Hudson*, displayed in the Folklife Gallery at Crandall Public Library during December 2003 and January 2004.

These photographs, mostly taken by Gretchen McHugh in 2003, show industrial sites along the Hudson River from Bakers Falls in Washington County, Glens Falls in Warren County, and finally upstream to Spier Falls Dam. Shown are paper mills (International Paper, Finch Pruyn), General Electric plant, bridges, dams, canals (especially the Feeder Canal in Glens Falls).
