## OVERVIEW OF THE RECORDS

- Abstract:** This collection consists of one photo album of unknown origin. Several of the photos are labeled Mountain Lake, which most likely refers to the Mountain Lake north of Gloversville, NY. Other photos were labeled as Caroga Lake, Sacandaga, Stoller's Ravine, and Thousand Island. Others were taken in Turlock, CA and Monrovia, CA. The photos were taken around the turn of the 20<sup>th</sup> century and most appear to be family portraits. (Accession # 1994-006)

## SCOPE AND CONTENT OF THE RECORDS

This collection contains one photo album of 38 pages. The black and white photos were glued to black paper and most were labeled. The captions include: Mountain Lake (Bessie, Dayton, Ira, and Deen), Caroga Lake, Christmas 1898, Sacandaga, Stoller's Ravine 1899, Deal Lake—Asbury Park, Battle of Johnstown boulder, Thousand Island, Turlock, CA, and Monrovia, CA. The majority of the photos were taken in the Upper Hudson region. Most appear to be family portraits and family vacation photos, however, no surnames are mentioned. The dates listed are 1898, 1899, 1910, and 1914. The provenance of the album is unknown. It was given to Crandall Public Library on May 18, 1994.
