SCOPE AND CONTENT OF THE RECORDS

Antiques Scrapbook describes houses and their interior design and especially decorative or useful objects, such as furniture, glass, china, silver, stoves and ovens, wooden utensils, butter molds, paints and dyes, foot scrapers, and. The emphasis is on the Victorian period, although some earlier objects are described. The geographic focus is New England and New York State, including New York City. The scrapbook contains newspaper clippings, magazine articles, handwritten notes, and colored cards. The compiler is unknown, but most articles date from about 1934 to 1959.
