- Abstract:** This scrapbook consists of Christmas cards, holiday cards, greeting cards, advertising cards, and calling or visiting cards. This material, mostly in color, was probably assembled by a woman. In addition, there are seven folders of loose items. One black and white studio photograph by Sauter is also included in the collection, along with several postcards of Schroon Lake, N.Y.

SCOPE AND CONTENT OF THE RECORDS

This scrapbook consists of Christmas cards, holiday cards, greeting cards, advertising cards, and calling or visiting cards. This material, mostly in color, contains mainly images of flowers, birds, and children. Because of the subject matter, this scrapbook was probably assembled by a woman. In addition to the scrapbook, there are seven folders of loose items, most of which were not part of the scrapbook but were included with it. One black and white studio portrait photograph by George Philip Sauter, inscribed and measuring 3"x 4½" is also included in the collection. Several postcards of Schroon Lake, N.Y., and one of the Eagle Lake Hotel are also part of the collection.

Folder 1 4 Christmas cards

Folder 2 The Last Supper advertisement card

Folder 3 1 empty box of Coty parfum, 1 greeting card, 1 name card, "Grace A. Rounds"

Folder 4 article from McCall's magazine dated February 1955, which explains the "Reward of Merit" card on page 13 of the scrapbook.

Folder 5 page from another scrapbook, which is a different size than the scrapbook. On one side is an advertisement for the Grand Union Tea Company, while the opposite side consists of decorative stamps – 1 has the name Lena Taylor, and another has the name Lena S. Havens.

Folder 6 Postcards – 6 of Schroon Lake, N.Y., and one of Eagle Lake, N.Y.

Folder 7 Black and white 3"x 4 1/2" studio photograph with the inscription, "To dearest Teddy, with all my love, Jean."
