HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

Winifred Thomson was from Glens Falls but she moved to Johnstown, New York, following her marriage to Frank J. Argersinger (1880-1938), who was involved in the leather business in Johnstown. After Mr. Argersinger's death, Mrs. Argersinger moved back to Glens Falls, where she became assistant housekeeper at the Glens Falls Hospital. In September of 1941 she was married to John G. Gonseth of Clayton.

SCOPE AND CONTENT OF THE RECORDS

These scrapbooks were compiled by Winifred Thomson Argersinger Gonseth and contain newspaper clippings mostly from Glens Falls newspapers. The clippings are dated 1927-1958, and one 1924 letter is present. The emphasis is mainly on the history of Glens Falls and the surrounding area, but some historical material pertaining to Albany and the Adirondack region is also included. There are also numerous articles about people, especially high school students, marriage announcements, retirements, anniversaries, senior citizens. Many obituaries can be found in these volumes. There are also articles about organizations and businesses, especially Glens Falls Hospital. Some articles are from the Centennial Edition of the *Glens Falls Times*, April 24, 1939. Pages are numbered but no index is available.
