## OVERVIEW OF THE RECORDS

- Abstract:** This is an album prepared by an unidentified palmist. Many of the people whose palms are recorded in the album are identified and the hand carefully described. Some palms are dated between 1902 and 1903, but many are undated.

## SCOPE AND CONTENT OF THE RECORDS

This is an album of an unidentified palmist, probably from New York State. Many of the palms recorded in the album are identified and carefully described. Some are dated between 1902 and 1903. The compiler placed the palm recordings in a published volume entitled, *Clapp & Company, Bankers: Leading American Exchanges. Souvenir, 1893*. Some of the palms are recorded on blank sheets of paper from the General Superintendent's Office, Chateaugay Railroad Co., Plattsburgh, N.Y. or from the Grand Trunk Railway System.
