SCOPE AND CONTENT OF THE RECORDS

The scrapbook was created from clippings collected by Jack ("Rosie") Rosenberg, Post Master (retired 2012), Shushan, Town of Salem, Washington County, NY. He clipped articles from the newspaper which he thought were of interest to Shushan residents and posted them in the Post Office. He saved them and they came to the Folklife Center through the intervention of Folklife Center Director and Shushan resident Todd DeGarmo. The clippings were photocopied in triplicate and sleeved in binders by volunteer Nina Paranjpe, with one copy for the Folklife Center, one for the Salem Town Historian, and, originally, one to go back to the Post Office. Subsequent closure of the Post Office has necessitated a change of plan for that volume. Clippings were taken primarily from the *Post-Star* of Glens Falls, NY, but also from the *Journal-Press* of Greenwich, NY, the *Eagle* of Cambridge, NY, and perhaps other papers. Not all of the clippings are dated and sourced. Clippings include obituaries, gallery openings, accidents, fires and other tragedies, and local events of every sort.
