## SCOPE AND CONTENT OF THE RECORDS

This scrapbook by an unknown compiler has newspaper clippings from April 29 to May 9, 1898, pertaining to the Spanish-American War. The focus of the scrapbook is mobilizing and training the National Guard militia volunteers from upstate New York communities, including Glens Falls and Troy. One of the National Guard units described is the 18<sup>th</sup> Separate Company, Second Regiment, New York Volunteers, from Glens Falls. Also included are accounts of the training of these troops at Camp Black, Hempstead Plains, Long Island, New York or at the State Camp, Peekskill, New York.
