

# VERMONT SCRAPBOOK AND LEDGER

## OVERVIEW OF THE RECORDS

- Abstract:** This volume contains newspaper clippings pasted in an old ledger which is 8" x 10" with a blue cover. The scrapbook was probably compiled in the 1890s by a woman, who may have lived in Vermont. Subjects include travel, religion and morality, politics, poetry, England, the 1893 World's Fair, the Civil War, and James A. Garfield. The ledger, dated 1853-1855 from Vermont, includes receipts for mail and 1855 election returns.

### SCOPE AND CONTENT OF THE RECORDS

This volume is a scrapbook pasted over the pages of an old ledger. The scrapbook contains newspaper clippings and some manuscript entries. The scrapbook was probably compiled in the 1890s by someone who may have lived in Vermont. The main subjects include travel, religion and morality, politics, poetry, England, the 1893 World's Fair at Chicago, the Civil War, and James A. Garfield. Included are poems and stories about babies, kittens, girls, mothers, famous women, and temperance, suggesting that the compiler was probably a woman. The ledger, dated 1853-1855, includes receipts for the Eastern mail and the Southern mail in Vermont, personal accounts of cash received, and election returns for Vermont in 1855.
